

Registration v. 1.4 Features List

Morris Digital Works presents a new and improved Registration system. Our latest version, 1.4, offers the following outstanding enhancements:

Integration of Additional Services

- ❑ Each new version of Registration strives to integrate more services to ensure the user only has to register once. **Email List** (customers specifically sign up for information to be sent to them via email; frequently used for “Breaking News”) and **Headline Push** (customers select the option to have newspaper headlines sent to them by email at a schedule they specify) have been integrated for this version.

Users Have More Control Over Their Accounts

- ❑ Additional self-service features have been added to allow users to troubleshoot basic registration problems without turning to newspapers for support.
- ❑ Users can reactivate/deactivate their accounts as desired.

E-mail Validation Required of Users to Remain Active

- ❑ Users who wish to access the protected areas are sent a validation email upon signup.
- ❑ They must validate their emails within a newspaper-defined validation period or become deactivated.
- ❑ They are, however, given access within that validation period.

Automatic Account Deactivation

- ❑ Users that don't validate within the validation period are automatically deactivated by the system once the period is exceeded.

Users Can Change Email Addresses and Still Get Immediate Access

- ❑ Active users who edit their email addresses can have access to the protected content, but they are sent validation emails and must validate within the customer-defined validation period to maintain access.
- ❑ Deactivated users who edit their email addresses do not have access to the protected content, but they are sent validation emails and can validate to get access.

Newspapers Can Administer User Accounts in Administration Area

- ❑ An Administrator area allows newspapers to troubleshoot user accounts, deactivate users, and change user passwords.

Integration of Third-Party Tools

- ❑ The following third-party tools can be integrated with Registration 1.4:
 - Exact Target
 - Omniture
 - Tacoda

Dynamic Content Restriction Options Now Available

- ❑ Content generated from the database can now be restricted to unregistered users.
