



Convera Template Implementation for Archives

This document provides a list of the Convera templates used for all MDW Archives implementations (currently only Augusta and Savannah), and an explanation of the functionality for each template. It also provides information on what template changes are necessary for customization.

Intended Audience

This document is for internal use only.

Convera Template List

The table below lists all files that must be installed for an Archives implementation.

Filename	Explanation
advanced_search.html	This is the same as the search.html template, but contains more options for users. Also provides the ability to perform searches with date ranges.
cqcgi.tpt	The configuration file which sets the main variables and where the library is initially set. It also specifies which templates go where (using variables). <i>Example:</i> If the following variable is set in the cqcgi.tpt file: CQ_MAIN main.html then whenever the URL contains cq_main=yes, the main.html page is displayed Note: The library can also be set in the url.
display_pdf.html	This template is included in the framed_display.html page via i-frames. It is the template that grabs the pdf that you are looking for as well as the xml file used for highlighting the keywords
error_login_failed.html	If a login fails for any reason this page is displayed
footer.html	This is the footer file that all display templates use to maintain each property's branding.
framed_display.html	This template is the main page returned when you click on a search result. It includes the pdf as well as navigation to go to the next page in that section.
header.html	This is the header file that all display templates use to maintain each property's branding.
logout.html	This is displayed when the user logs out of Convera
main.html	This is the main template. It includes the search template and displays user search results.
navigation.html	This is the navigation template, which is the final template included to display navigation in a particular section of the newspaper on the framed_display.html page.
process_navigation.html	This is the process navigation page. In order to display navigation for a particular newspaper section, a new session key must be generated to get back a different set of results (all of the pages in a particular section).
search.html	This is the template that generates the basic search form. It is included in the main template and performs basic search functionality.

Customizing the Convera Templates for a Specific Property

Customizing the branding for an individual property is accomplished by modifying the following templates:

Template Filename	Necessary Modifications
header.html	Change to include the property's logo /graphics, etc. Note: This is not the file that provides the top navigation tabs.
footer.html-	Change to include the property's copyright information, privacy policy, contact info, etc.
search.html	Must change the library for the property
advanced_search.html-	Must change the libray for the property.
framed_display.html	Provides the display mechanism for the pages. Modification is necessary only if you want the frames displayed differently.
